NOTICE OF PROPOSED CODE AMENDMENT

At the January 13, 2025 Council meeting the City Council will take into consideration and vote on a proposed change to the City Code, Title III, Chapter 32, Subdiv. 32.01 as is indicated below. The deletions from the current Code are struck out and the additions underlined. These changes are being proposed to reflect the information provided by the League of MN Cities regarding the roles of the Mayor and Council members.

CHAPTER 32: CITY OFFICERS

' 32.01 MAYOR.

The Mayor shall preside at each meeting of the Council. he or she shall supervise all officers, committee chairpersons, and department heads in the performance of their duties; he or she shall take steps as may be reasonably necessary to ensure that the business of the city is promptly and fully carried out and that the city ordinances, code provisions, and applicable state laws are enforced. The Mayor has all the powers and duties for the office of Council member in addition to those of Mayor. He or she serves as the official head of the city by representing the city before the Minnesota Legislature, federal agencies, and other local governments; performs ceremonial duties for the community; and provides leadership in City affairs. The Mayor shall execute official documents and contracts authorized by Council and declare local emergencies following MN State Statute requirements and timelines.
