Street Parking

No vehicle shall be parked or allowed to stand for more than 24 hours on any of the public streets or alleys in the City. The City can at any time upon notice require vehicles to be moved in the event of snow removal. The City may also designate an area as no parking at any time for the purpose of snow removal. Where parking has been restricted for snow removal purposes, parking may be resumed on individual streets as soon as snow has been removed and where parking will not interfere with remaining snow removal work. Cars that are parked longer than 24 hours and are interfering with snow removal will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

For those residents that live along Highway 32, the State Highway Department keeps the highway clean, and since it's frequently plowed during the early morning hours, State plow operators would also appreciate it if no vehicles are parked on Highway 32 overnight.
